SHOES

The only acceptable school shoes at Heron Hall High School are:

Plain grey flat leather polishable sensible shoes (not boots, plimsolls or trainers) with no coloured trim, laces or contrasting stitching.

The examples of footwear below are unacceptable as shoes for school, this includes Nike Air Forces, Converse, Vans (including leather Vans and Converse) grey trainers and boots.

JEWELLERY AND HAIR

Jewellery:

- 1 pair of plain gold or silver- coloured ear studs or one single stud.
- Necklaces must be underneath the school shirt.

Hair:

- We expect hairstyles suitable for the school environment.
- · Only black, brown or blonde dyed hair is acceptable.
- · No other dyed colours or streaks are acceptable.
- Tramlines and shaved head designs are not acceptable.
- No slits shaved in eyebrows.
- · Hair extensions/braids must be in natural hair colours.
- · Boys must be clean shaven.

Religious and/or cultural dispensation may be applied for at the school, for permission to allow the growth of facial hair. Permission may be granted at the discretion of the Headteacher.

COATS

- · Sensible school coat in a dark colour must be worn.
- No leather or denim jackets.
- No hoodies allowed at any time.
- No sweatshirts, tracksuit tops or cardigans.



HATS & ACCESSORIES

- No hats to be worn in the building at any time.
- Woollen or fleece hats allowed in the playground during winter.
- No caps at any time.
- Phones and headphones should not be visible during the school day.

TATTOOS

- No Tattoos.
- Existing tattoos must be completely covered up.

BLAZER AND JUMPER

A school grey blazer must be worn at all times around the school building. The blazer must have the school badge on the breast pocket.

- · Jumpers should be plain grey V-neck.
- Round-neck jumpers or sweatshirts are not allowed.
- No logos.
- · A jumper cannot be worn instead of a blazer.





SCHOOL BAGS

Should be an appropriate size for school books (up to A4 size) and equipment. i.e. Rucksack or messenger bag style.

SHIRTS

- · Plain white. No sports shirts allowed.
- Shirt has top button done up and must be tucked inside trousers/skirts at all times.







SCHOOL TIE

- A white school shirt must be worn fully buttoned to the neck, along with a correctly positioned school tie.
- Tie must be at least 4 grey/red stripes long.



MAKEUP AND NAILS

- · Make up should be minimal.
- Coloured nail varnish, false nails and false eyelashes are not allowed.
- · Clear nail varnish may be worn.





HAIR BANDS AND BOBBLES

 Hair bands, scrunchies, bobbles and headscarves must be grey or white.







- Head bands and ties are not permitted.
- Head scarves must be worn properly and not as a fashion accessory, they also need to be neat and tied.

BELTS

 Belts must be plain grey or black with a small buckle.



TROUSERS

Plain grey, straight cut, medium width, regular fit or pleated; may have turn-ups; shoe length. As a preference, we encourage students to wear the specially designed school trousers with the Heron Hall logo on them. You can buy these trousers at Smiths Schoolwear www.smithsschoolwear.co.uk.

Examples of acceptable trousers:



This **DOES NOT** include any of the following: denim trousers, trousers with rivets, trousers with a low waist, trousers made of any stretchy material, trousers that are tight below the knee, skinny style trousers, trousers made of any fabric other than standard school trouser fabric, leggings / jeggings, thick tights used as trousers, trousers that are not full length.

Banned Trouser types:



SKIRTS

- Plain grey or black, 'A' line style, no split, may include a fan pleat; or fully pleated. No lycra.
- Skirt length on or below the knee. As a preference, we encourage students to wear the specially designed school skirts with the Heron Hall logo on them.



SOCKS

- Plain grey or black socks may be worn (Patterned socks are not acceptable).
- Students may wear plain grey, opaque, white or flesh coloured tights. Patterned tights and leg warmers are not acceptable.
- Students are allowed to wear socks that are calf length (below the knee) These socks must be grey.
- No ankle socks.



REPORTING UNIFORM ISSUES TO THE SCHOOL

In case of any emergency please contact your child's Year Attainment Manager (Head of Year).

SANCTIONS

Any pupil who is not following the schools uniform rules will be sent home to change and given an after-school detention.

Students who do not bring their PE kit on the day of PE lessons will be given an after-school detention.
