**Re – Year 9 HPV2 catch up Immunisation Appointment**

**Venue** : Millfield Theatre, Silver Street, Edmonton, London, N18 1PJ

**Date** : 28<sup>th</sup> January 2021

Now more than ever, the importance of vaccinations to prevent the outbreak of infectious diseases has been highlighted by the NHS, who are urging parents to bring their children forward for these lifesaving vaccines, throughout Covid-19 and beyond.

The Enfield Immunisation Team is continuing its service during current school closures due to Coronavirus. Even though the school remains closed for normal school activities, we are running clinics at the above venue to provide immunisations that would have been given in school.

**Please note that this vaccination is for the second dose of the HPV vaccination. Your child should have already received their first dose in School whilst they were in year 8, this second dose will complete the course.**

**If you did not consent for your child to have their first dose of the vaccine in year 8, but have now changed your mind, please also bring your child to the above session, as it is not too late.**

Immunisation appointment timings will be arranged alphabetically according to the first letter of your child's surname; please see below, and bring your child to their allocated slot

Surname begins with A-C please attend between	<b>10am – 10:30am</b>
Surname begins with D-F please attend between	<b>10:30am – 11am</b>
Surname begins with G-I please attend between	<b>11am – 11:30am</b>
Surname begins with J-L please attend between	<b>11:30am – 12pm</b>

Surname begins with M-O please attend between	<b>12:30pm – 1pm</b>
Surname begins with P-S please attend between	<b>1pm – 1:30pm</b>
Surname begins with T-W please attend between	<b>1:30pm – 2pm</b>
Surname begins with X-Z please attend between	<b>2pm – 2:30pm</b>

The safety of all young people, families and staff will always be of the highest priority and consequently extra infection control measures will be in place to protect them throughout.. Please note that all NHS staff will be wearing PPE.

**If you think your child or any member of your family household has, or think they have symptoms of Coronavirus, please do not attend this appointment. Symptoms include fatigue, fever, persistent cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, diarrhoea, chills and skin rashes.**

- Please be on time so we can manage the session safely for the benefit of all. Please note that latecomers may not be seen
- The young person can be accompanied by 1 adult only
- Facemasks should be worn by both young person and the accompanying adult
- Standard Covid-19 screening questions will be asked prior to admission to the building
