**Online learning and return to school day timings throughout the week beginning 8<sup>th</sup> March**

At the beginning of January, we adapted the timings of online lessons to ensure that all students and teachers followed the same school day timings throughout the national lockdown.

With students due to return to school next week, we will need to revert back to the normal lesson times for lessons which will also apply to live online learning lessons throughout the week beginning the 8<sup>th</sup> March. This is partly due to the fact that we will be having a staggered return to school for pupils. Teachers will need to follow the same lesson timings for those pupils in school and those pupils that will be continuing with their online learning. It will also be a good opportunity for students to readjust to their normal school day times meaning that the transition back to school is also supported.

Below is a summary of the online learning provision and timings that each year group will follow. Please also be reminded that on the day their year group is required onsite to participate in the lateral flow testing there will be no live lessons on that day – work will be uploaded by class teachers via google classroom.
