Dear Parent/Carer.

We are writing to you as we look ahead to your child's GCSE journey with us at Heron Hall Academy. As you know your child will be sitting their GCSE exams at the end of this academic year. ## <u>Intervention Programme – Term 1</u>

- Morning (before school) from 7:45am to 8:30am breakfast will be provided

Your child has been selected to attend one or more sessions in the subject or subjects they need the most support. Your child has been provided with a personalise timetable.

The expectation is that your child will attend the session or sessions to which they have been invited and we are asking you to support us in ensuring that your child is punctual and that they actively participate in the intervention session.
