I would like to invite you to attend our Parents' Consultation meeting on Thursday 05<sup>th</sup> January 2023 between 4.30pm – 7.00pm, these meetings will be face-to-face. This will be an opportunity to speak to subject teachers about your child's GCSE options.

We will be using Arbor, as the booking system. This system allows you to choose your own appointment times and receive confirmation emails.

Appointments can be made online from Thursday 08<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and will close on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2022 at 5pm. As always there will be one appointment slot given per child for each subject teacher which will last no longer than 5 minutes. It is important that we stick to this allocated time so the meetings do not overrun; if you wish to discuss further, you can arrange another meeting with your child's class teacher.

- Parent/Carer's Email Address
- Child's DOB

Take particular care when entering your details, especially with the date of birth and email address. If the login cannot be validated because any of these details are incorrect, please let the office know so that we can amend your records as soon as possible.

Attending this event is really important to us and your child's future achievement, particularly in this year as they prepare to choose their GCSE options.

At this event you will have the opportunity to:

- Collect a copy of your child's report which will include their recent mock examination grades
- Meet with your child's subject teachers for confidential discussions about their studies
- Find out about what support is available to help with preparation for exams
- Help your child to plan for success Madam Davies-Walters, Assistant Headteacher will be at hand to provide information.



Meet with Madam Marangi, Year 9 Head of Year to discuss any concerns or factors which
you feel we should know to support your child. Madam Marangi will be able to share these
concerns with your child's tutor and provide additional support if needed.
