Dear families,

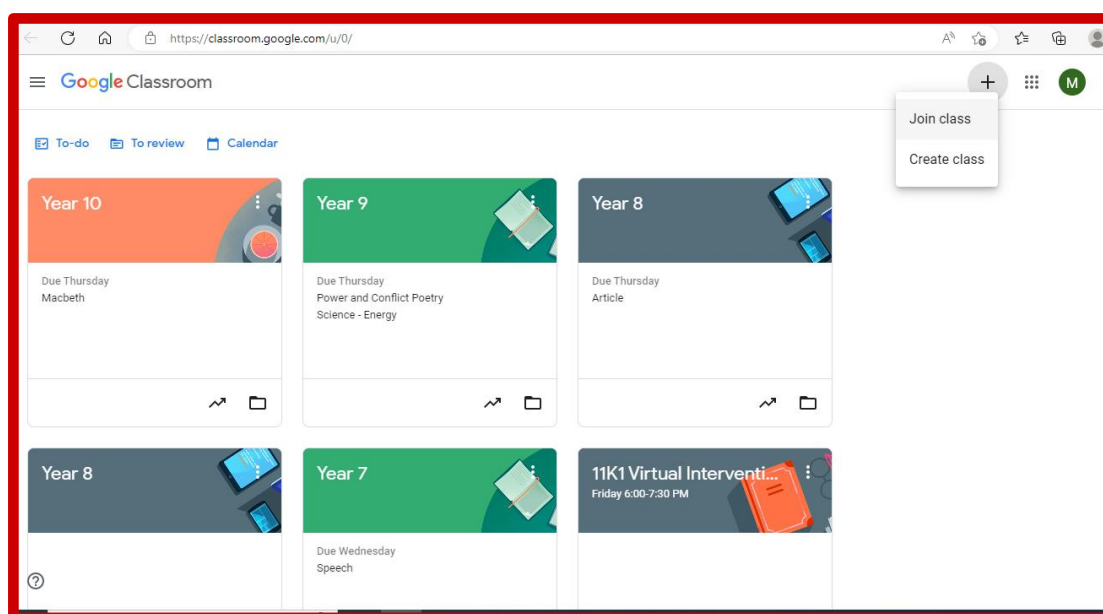
A second national schools' strike is planned by the NEU, the largest teachers' union, for Thursday, 2 March.

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the day and what it will mean for your child.

The Department for Education (DfE) is again expecting all schools to put plans in place to provide education for as many children as possible when a strike takes place. All schools are in the same situation.

On Thursday, March 2, all Year 11 students must arrive at school no later than 8:40. Students with "Key Workers" parents, vulnerable pupils, and EHCP children are also encouraged to attend class on the day of the strike. Students in grades 7, 8, 9, and 10 will have online access to instruction. Please follow these instructions to gain access to the online learning:

1. Access Google Classroom by using your school email address.
2. By selecting the "+" sign in the top right corner, select "join class."



3. Where it asks for a class code, provide the code for your year group.
