I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the next two day and what it will mean for your child.

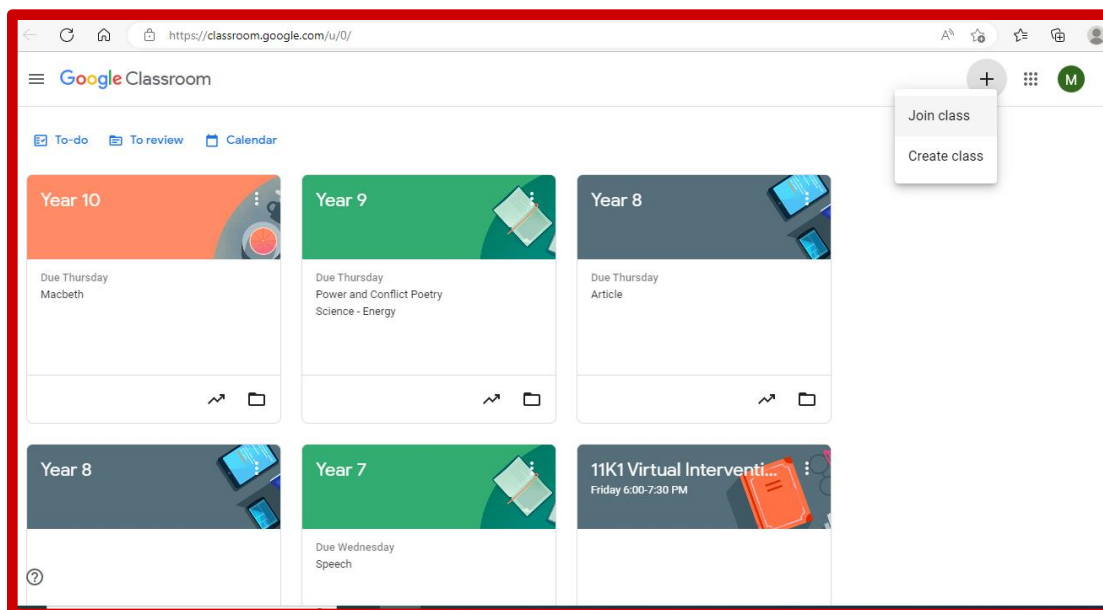
The Department for Education (DfE) is again expecting all schools to put plans in place to provide education for as many children as possible when a strike takes place. All schools are in the same situation.



2. By selecting the "+" sign in the top right corner, select "join class."




3. Where it asks for a class code, provide the code for your year group.
