



RE: Strike action by the National Education Union (NEU) - arrangements for Thursday 27th of April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023

Dear families,

More national teacher strikes are planned by the NEU, the largest teachers' union, for Thursday 27th of April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023.

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the day and what it will mean for your child.

The Department for Education (DfE) is again expecting all schools to put plans in place to provide education for as many children as possible when a strike takes place. All schools are in the same situation.

All **Year 11** students must be at school by 8:40am on Thursday 27th of April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023.

The year 11 GCSE Art examination will run as normal on Thursday the 27th April and it is essential that all Year 11 Art students attend their public examination on this day.

We will also be providing a 'hub' for:

- *Vulnerable children in Years 7-10 - those who are SEND or on a ECHP plan*
- *The children from families who are classified as 'keyworkers' in the following jobs: Police, doctors, nurses, paramedics, and teachers who are working.*

All other students in years **7, 8, 9, and 10** will access learning online. To access the online learning, please complete these steps:

1. Access Google Classroom by using your institution's email address.

3. Where it asks for a class code, provide the code for your year group.
