## **Year 7 Settling In Evening Appointments**

Our year 7 students have now been a member of the Heron Hall family for 2 weeks, and we would like to take the opportunity for you to come in and meet with your child's form tutor on **Thursday 21**st **September 2023**.

Appointments must be made on **Arbor** from Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September at 3pm and will close on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September at 1pm. As always there will be one appointment slot given per child for each form teacher which will last no longer than 5 minutes. It is important that we stick to this allocated time so the meetings do not overrun; if you wish to discuss this further, you can arrange another meeting with your child's class teacher.

This is where you will be able to book your appointment from the date stated above. Login will be validated against the following information that we hold:

- Parent/Carer's Email Address
- Child's DOB
