

## What to expect on results day

### 1. **When and where can I collect my results?**

You will be able to collect your results from the Sports Hall on the 22<sup>nd</sup> August. Envelopes will be organised by surname.

If you are unavailable to come and collect your results, a parent or guardian will be able to collect your results on the day, they will need to complete the “results permission collection form by 1<sup>st</sup> August and email it to [exams.heron@northstartrust.org.uk](mailto:exams.heron@northstartrust.org.uk)

### 2. **What time would I be able to collect my results?**

You will be able to collect your results from 8:30am

### 3. **Can I get my papers re-marked?**

Please read the information enclosed about the process of remarking.

Once in the sports hall after you have received your results you will be directed to a desk with consent for remark forms, every student must sign this form and leave with the member of staff.

### 4. **What advice can get I get for my next steps?**

There will be staff available to discuss all of your options and answer any questions you may have in relation to careers, colleges, subject choices etc.

### 5. **When can I enrol for Sixth form?**

Enrolment for Heron Hall Sixth Form will take place on results day, the Sixth Form team will be available to help you with your next steps.

### 6. **What courses are on offer?**

We have 3 pathways on offer:

•**Academic pathway: A-Levels** - Business, History, Maths, English Literature, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Government and Politics, Geography, Sociology, Psychology, Art and Media Studies.

•**Vocational pathway: Vocational Level 3** - Health and Social Care, Sports Studies and Travel and Tourism

•**STEPS: GCSE and BTEC Level 2 resit courses** - Maths, English, Health and Social Care and IT.

### 7. What are the entry requirements for the different courses?

•**A-levels** - 6 GCSE (including English and maths at a minimum of grade 4 and at least 3 passes at grade 6) plus the subject specific entry requirements

•**Vocational** - 5 GCSE (including English and maths at a minimum grade 4) plus the subject specific entry requirement

•**STEPS** - 4 GCSEs at grades 2/3

### 8. How many courses can I pick?

**A Levels** - You must pick 3 A-levels. They must however be from 3 separate blocks to ensure that they do not clash.

**Vocational** - Just pick one, as this is equivalent to picking 3 A-levels. So, you can only pick either health and social care, sports studies or travel and tourism

### 9. What do I need to enrol?

A copy of GCSE certificates to finalise your conditional offer. These must then be shown to a member of the sixth form team who will confirm your choices and register you.

### 10. Will there be other dates and times to enrol apart from results day?

Enrolment will continue Friday 23rd August from 9am to 12pm. Further dates and times will be advertised on the school website.
