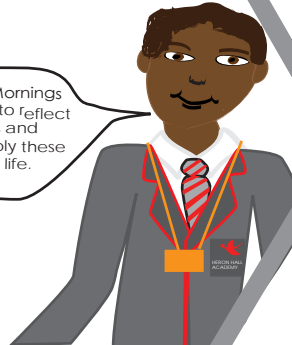
STRIVE ASSEMBLIES

During STRIVE Mornings it gives us a time to reflect on our values and learn how to apply these values to our life.

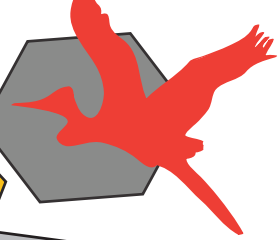


STRIVE SPEAKERS

Merits linked to the STRIVE values are added up and every term the person with the most in the year wins a certificate and prize.

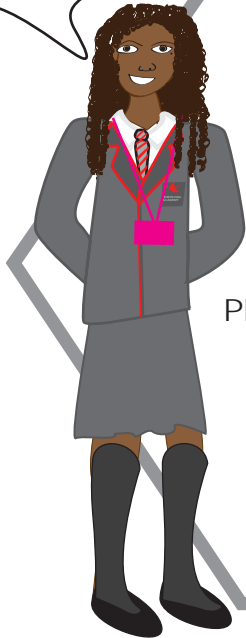


How should I get ready for my first day?

A plain grey V-neck jumper.

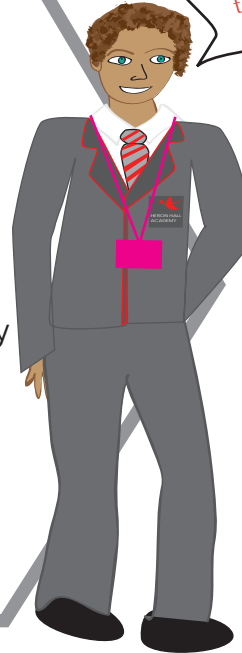
Plain white shirt.

A school tie with at least 4 red stripes showing.

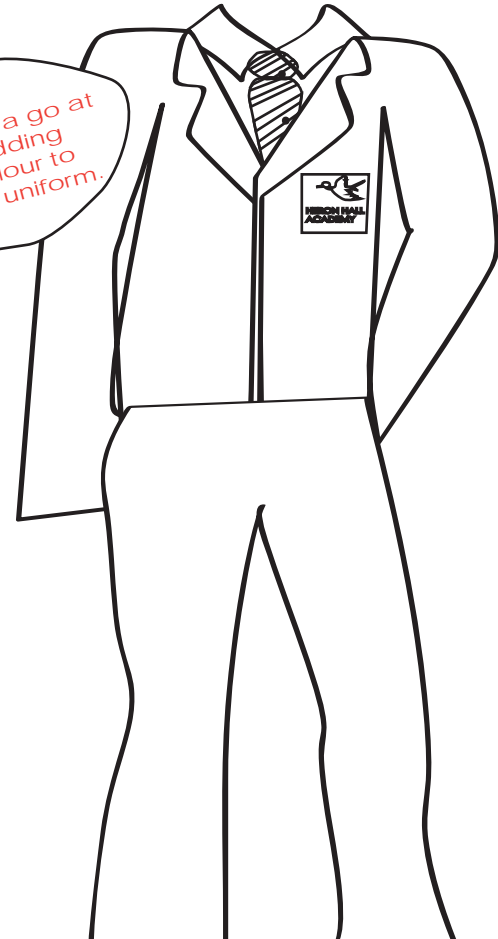
Plain grey trousers or plain grey skirt to the knee.

Plain grey or black flat polishable sensible shoes.

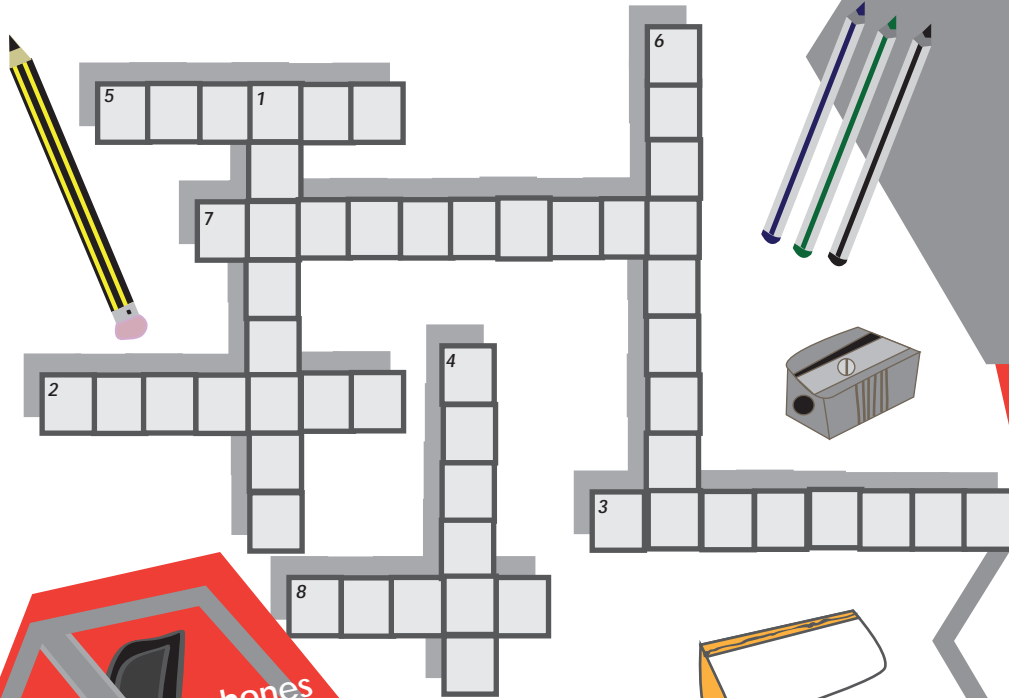


Have a go at adding colour to the uniform.

It's a good idea to pack your backpack the evening before, to make sure you do not forget anything in the morning.

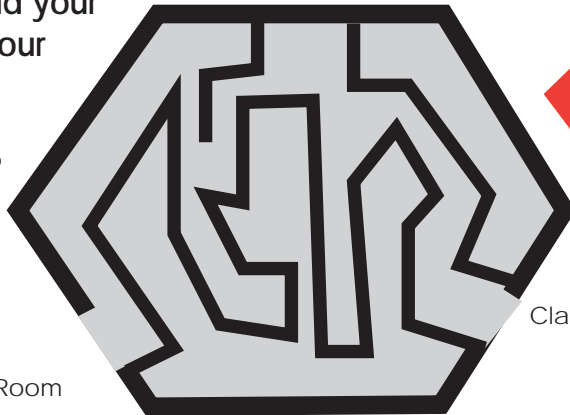
What happens in a school day?

 You should be at school for 8:35 ready for line up in the morning with your form.

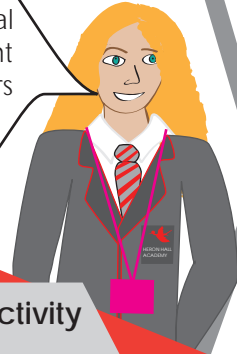
 Every day you have 5 Periods, other than Thursday. **On Thursday you finish after Period 4.**

Where to go for support




At Heron Hall Academy we know that starting secondary school can be an exciting and anxious time.
