Joining the Academy Advisory committee as a parent governor offers you the opportunity to: -

- Help the school provide the best possible enrichment opportunities through school trips (e.g. galleries, museums, zoos, arts events) and a wide range of extra-curricular activities.

Being a governor can be very rewarding and will provide you with the opportunity to work as part of a team and gain new skills. The most important duty of governors is to attend regular advisory committee meetings and visit the school to make observations and monitor. You should be sure that you are committed and available to do so before applying.

You may nominate yourself or another parent however all nominees must complete a parent governor nomination form and personal statement and return it to Sherene Graham Headteachers EA or scan it in an email to heron@northstartrust.org.uk no later than 4.00pm on Wednesday 9th July 2025.

If necessary, an election will be held and further details including voting timescales will be communicated to parents. Before signing the form, all nominees should check that they are not disqualified from becoming a parent governor for any of the reasons provided with the form.
