At Heron Hall Sixth Form, you'll study in small classes with expert teachers who help you aim high and stay supported.

Every course opens new doors - to university, apprenticeships, and future careers - so you can build a pathway that fits your ambitions.

A LEVEL COURSES

Art & Design: Fine Art

Develop creativity through drawing, painting and mixed media while building a portfolio that reflects your own ideas. This course inspires confidence and prepares you for art and design degrees.

Art & Design: Photography

Learn to capture stories through images using professional techniques. You'll build creative and technical skills valued in media, design and communication.

Biology

Explore life - from cells and genetics to ecosystems and human biology. You'll gain scientific thinking and practical skills for health, science or environmental careers.

Business Studies

Understand how businesses work and make decisions. You'll study marketing, finance and strategy while developing skills that employers and universities value.

Chemistry

Discover how matter behaves and why reactions happen. The course builds analysis and lab experience for medicine, research and engineering.

Computer Science

Learn to code, solve problems and think logically. This is ideal preparation for computing, data and technology careers.

Economics

Examine how decisions made by individuals, markets, and the government shape everyday life. You'll learn to analyse evidence and debate real-world issues clearly.

English

Study great writing and express your ideas with impact. You'll strengthen communication, interpretation and critical-thinking skills.

Find out how decisions are made and who holds power. You'll develop debating and reasoning skills useful for law, politics and media.

History

Explore the events and ideas that shaped today's world. This course deepens understanding, curiosity and strong essay writing.

Mathematics

Challenge yourself with numbers, logic and problem-solving. Maths builds precision and supports success in science, finance and engineering.

Media Studies

Analyse film, television and social media while creating your own content. You'll gain creative and production experience for modern media careers.

Physics

Study forces, energy and the structure of the universe. Physics develops accuracy, reasoning and technical skills for STEM paths.

Psychology

Discover how people think, feel and behave. You'll learn to investigate questions scientifically and apply ideas to real life.

Sociology

Examine how society shapes culture, identity and opportunity. The course develops research and analytical skills valued in many professions.

Learn how to support people's health and wellbeing through practical and theory work. You'll prepare for caring professions such as nursing and social work.

Music Performance (Extended Certificate)

Build confidence as a performer and understand the music industry. You'll gain experience in rehearsal, recording and live events.

Performing Arts (Extended Certificate)

Combine acting, dance and stage craft. This course develops teamwork, creativity and communication for theatre and media careers.

Sport and Physical Activity (Extended Diploma)

Study coaching, fitness and sports science through hands-on learning. You'll prepare for roles in sport, teaching and health promotion.

Travel and Tourism (Extended Diploma)

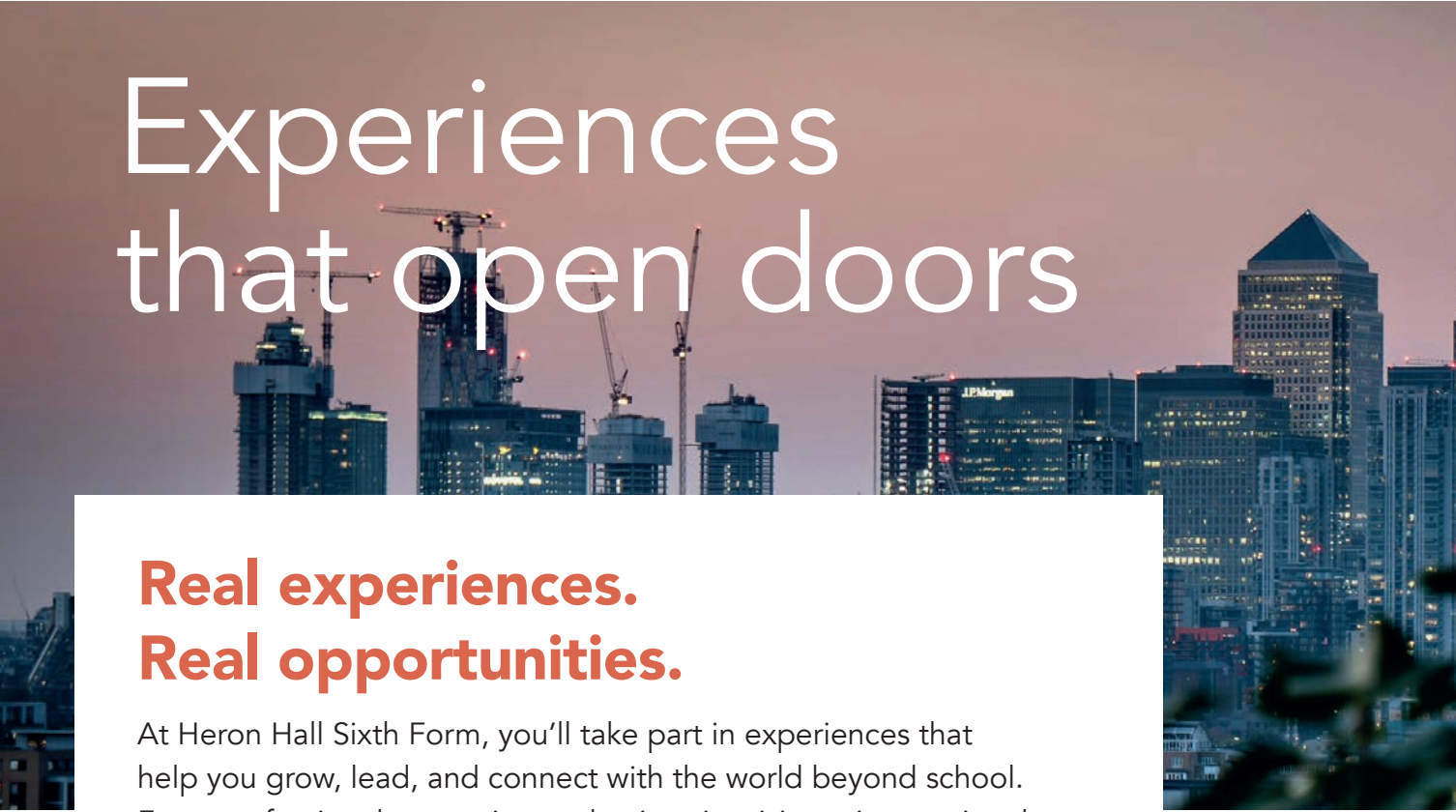
Explore destinations, events and customer service in a global industry. You'll gain business and communication skills for travel and hospitality careers.

How we support you

- Dedicated Sixth Form Team** – your first stop for any concern or advice.
- Personal tutor system** – regular 1-to-1 check-ins to track progress and wellbeing.

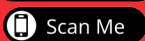
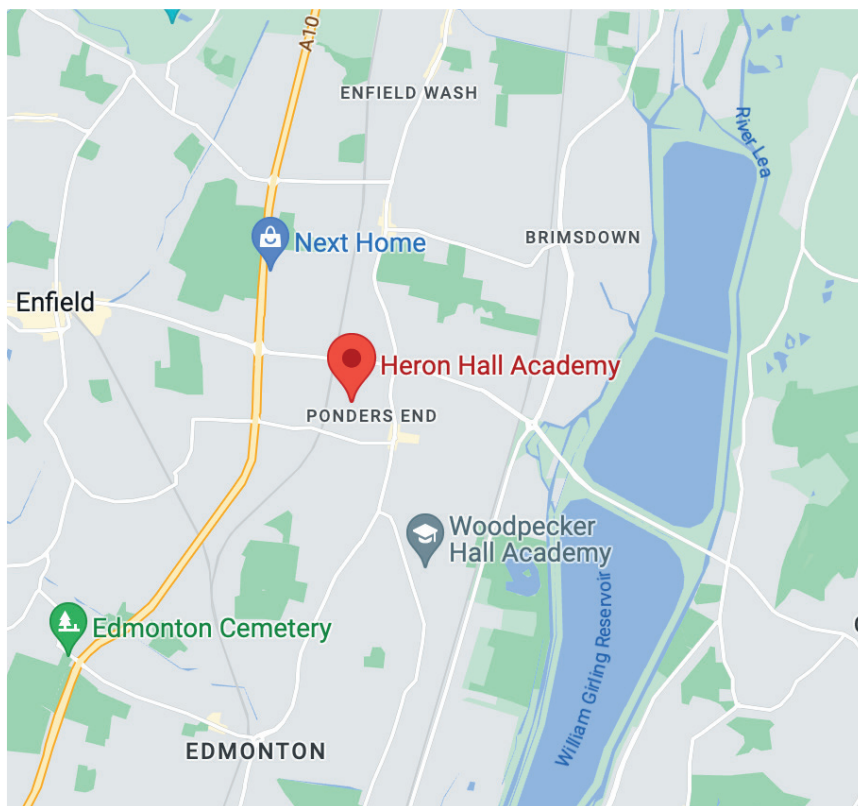
